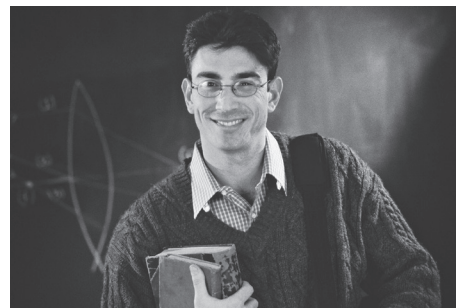


8 Speaking Worksheet
