FESTIVALS WORKSHEETS

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EASTER

Make a pop-up Easter card.

Materials: Template (page 4), an A4 sheet of paper, coloured crayons or pencils, scissors and glue.

- Give each child an Easter card template. Have them colour the picture and cut out the parts. Tell them to cut only where there is a dashed line. Ask them to fold the sheet of paper in half, show them how to stick the phrase and the picture on inside of the card, so it will pop up when it is opened. Encourage children to sign the card on the front, you can write *With love, from (x)* on the board and make them sign their names.



Make a candy holder.

Materials: Template (page 5), cardboard tube, coloured crayons or pencils, scissors, glue and some candy.

- Give each child an Easter rabbit template and a cardboard tube. Have them draw and colour the rabbit, decorate the tube and cut out the rabbit's body parts. Show them how to stick the different parts on the tube. Finally, put some candy in.



FATHER'S DAY

Make a Father's Day card.

Materials: Template (page 6), coloured crayons or pencils, scissors.

- Give each child a card template. Have them colour the pictures, write a short message of their preference on the front and sign their names. Show them how to fold the card in half, twice.

MOTHER'S DAY

Make a Mother's Day card.

Materials: Template (page 7), coloured crayons or pencils, scissors.

- Give each child a card template. Have them colour the pictures and sign their names on it. Show them how to fold the card in half, twice.

HALLOWEEN

Make a Halloween garland.

Materials: Template (page 8), coloured crayons or pencils, scissors and string.

- Give each child a Halloween objects template. Have them colour the pictures and cut the dashed lines. Help them make a small hole on top of every picture and thread a piece of string through them to make the garlands. Encourage children to hang the garlands and decorate the classroom.

Make a Halloween mask.

Materials: Template (page 9), scissors, elastic cord and different decorating materials, such as glitter, wool, sequins, etc.

- Give each child a mask template. Have them decorate it the way they prefer and cut it. Then, help them make a small hole on each side of the mask, so that they can tie the elastic cord and wear the mask. Encourage children to put on their masks and play.

CHRISTMAS

Make a Christmas tree.

Materials: Template (page 10), glue, scraps of coloured paper, fabric or ribbon, scissors.

- Give each child a Christmas tree template. Have them decorate the tree using scraps of paper, wrapping paper, fabric and ribbon and cut it out. Show them how to fit the sides of the tree together, so that the tree stands still. Display the Christmas trees around the classroom.


Make a Christmas card.


Materials: Template (page 11), coloured crayons or pencils, scissors.


