
There's a lot of food in summer and in autumn.

Harry the mouse is cold and hungry.



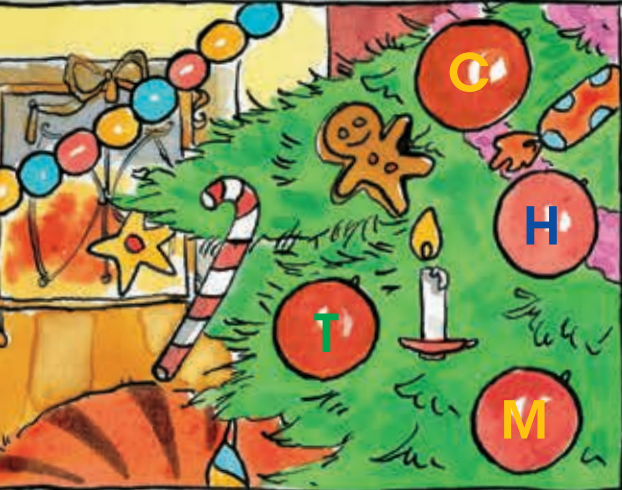
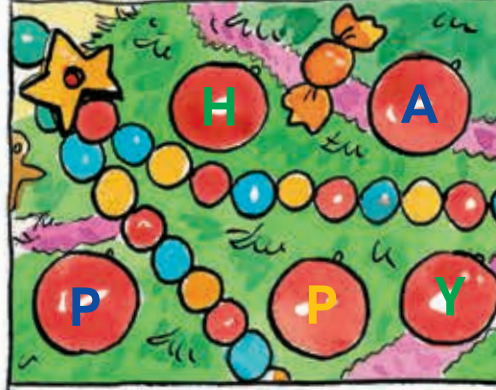
'I'm cold and hungry. I want a new home,' says
