

Communicative Grammar Game 4

Objective To find where some members of a family are by asking *Wh*-questions.

Grammar *Where is...?*

Interaction pairs

Preparation Make copies of Game 4 (1 per student).

Directions

Distribute copies of the game (see *Preparation*).

Review the names of the rooms and parts of the house by saying each word and having students point to the corresponding place.

Divide the class into pairs. Have students take turns asking each other where their family members are:

S1: *Where's your (mother)?*

S2: *She's in the (kitchen). Where's your (mother)?*

S1: *She's in the (yard).*

As their partner answers, tell students to write the word or make a quick drawing of their partner's family member. Encourage them to continue with other family members.

Finally, invite students to give their partner back their house with the location of their family members. If time allows, invite volunteers to the front to describe their picture: *This is my (mother). She's in the (yard).*
