

Communicative Grammar Game 8

Objective To find the names of some children in a park.

Grammar *What is he/she doing? What are they doing?*

Interaction pairs

Materials Unit 8 Flashcards or magazine cutouts of people doing an action

Preparation Make copies of Game 8 (1 per pair).

Directions

Using the flashcards or cutouts from magazines (see *Materials*), briefly review the questions: *What is he/she doing?* and *What are they doing?*

Then divide the class into pairs: A and B. Give each student a copy of the corresponding part of the game. Remind them not to show it to their partners. Invite them to say a sentence describing part of the scene: *A girl is (sleeping).*

Then call their attention to the names that they have at the bottom of their picture. Explain that they need to find who these children are by asking their partner *What is (Anna) doing?* or *What are (John and Paul) doing?* Then they write the name next to the child or children described.

As students do the activity, monitor and provide help as needed.

Finally, check answers by asking questions about each child's activity in the park.
