

# Communicative Grammar Game 9

**Objective** To collect fruit to make a fruit salad.

**Grammar** *What fruit do you have?*

**Interaction** teams

**Materials** paper (1 sheet for every 5 students),  
glue sticks, colored pencils

**Preparation** Make copies of Game 9 (1 for every  
15 students). Cut out and shuffle the cards.

## Directions

Review the names of different fruits by saying a color and having students name a fruit that has it:

T: *Red.*

Ss: *Apple, strawberries.*

Distribute the cards. Ask *What fruit do you have, (Sandra)?* to elicit the name of the fruit each student has. Then drill the question and write it on the board for reference.

Explain to students that they need to find four different students with a different fruit each to make a fruit salad. Remind them of the question on the board and start the activity.

As soon as students have five different fruits per group, ask them to shout *Fruit salad!* Check their cards and give them paper and glue (see *Materials*).

Invite teams to sit together with their colored pencils, as well. Have each student color his/her fruit and then ask the team to glue the fruits on the sheet of paper provided.
