

Communicative Grammar Game 7

Objective To find clothes to dress a doll.

Grammar *Do you have a (skirt)?*

Interaction whole class

Materials scissors, glue, colored pencils

Preparation Make copies of Game 7 (1 for every two students). Cut out a doll and four articles of clothing per student. Keep the rest in a box or envelope.

Directions

Do a brief review of articles of clothing. Then distribute the clothes only (see *Preparation*) and ask different students *Do you have a (skirt)?* Do a teacher-students drill, then student-student.

Distribute the dolls at random. Tell students that they need to dress their dolls using the clothes they have or by exchanging them with other students.

Encourage them to find the clothes they want by asking the question you drilled at the beginning of the class: *Do you have a (skirt)?*

For those students that cannot find the clothes they want, invite them to ask you the question. Use the spare clothes for this part of the activity.

As soon as students have the clothes for their doll, distribute the materials for them to dress them.

Finally, divide the class into pairs. Have students describe what their doll is wearing.
