An **eco-neighbourhood** is a sustainable urban project that reduces the impact on the environment. Residents can meet their needs and have access to services like electricity and heating without damaging nature.

These are some common characteristics that eco-neighbourhoods have to reduce carbon emissions:

>> There are solar panels and charging stations for electric or hybrid vehicles to promote the use of renewable energy.

>> Houses have sustainable materials and use renewable energy sources. For example, green roofs regulate the temperature inside and reduce energy use.

>> Shops and public buildings are near houses so people can walk or cycle there. Also, these communities are well connected to city centres by public

transport.

>> There are green areas for community gardens and recreation that help protect biodiversity, too.

>> There are systems to separate and compost waste to reduce pollution.

Eco-neighbourhoods are not only good for the environment but also for people's well-being and quality of life.
